

Flown directly into Canada weekly, all products are pre-cooled before departure from Australia and then immediately pre-cooled to 2 degrees Celsius upon arrival to ensure maximum freshness and vase life. When properly cut and hydrated in preservative treated water, Australian flowers and foliages are generally long lasting and can be arranged on their own or mixed in with more traditional cut flower varieties like roses to create a stunning effect of colors and textures!




