With the California wax season drawing to a close, Peru is ready to offer us excellent Israeli and Australian varieties from May to September. Grown in an arid area of Peru, the dry, desert like climate is perfect for the cultivation of Waxflower. Peru wax is graded in bunches of 350 grams with a minimum of 60cm in length. These hybrid megapetalum (large bloom) varieties develop well in water and have a long vase life. Peru, following the popular trend, is also offering a wide selection of tinted wax in yellow, blue, pink, green and orange.
